Mechanical Engineering Departmental Honors

Completion Requirements:

*Complete Application

*Minimum cum GPA 3.5

*Minimum 3hrs ME 451 or 452 UG Problems

*Minimum 3hrs ME 463 UG Honors Thesis

Overall Process:

- 1) Student SHOULD apply via ME Departmental Honors Application for ME Department Honors 5th or 6th semester (junior year) in the curriculum. **ACCEPTANCE** to this program **cannot** be granted **ANY** later than semester prior to graduation.
- 2) Application requires the supervising faculty instructor's signature and the signature of Director of ME UG Program.
- 3) Application is returned to the ME Advisement Program Coordinator for student file
- 4) Student must enroll in a minimum of 3hrs of UG Problems (ME 451- fall or 452-spring)
- 5) Within 2 semesters of taking UG Problems the student is required to enroll in a minimum of 3hrs of UG Honors Thesis (ME 463).
- 6) Student complete BSME with a minimum of 3.5 cum GPA (cum laude).

Course Requirements:

- 1) Student enrolls in UG Problems (ME 451-fall or 452- spring) with instructor's approval.
 - No later than the 4th week of the semester student writes a short summary of what they will be doing & has signed by instructor
 - Student submits that sign summary to Advisement office for student file by the end of the 4th week of the semester.
 - No later than "finals week" student provides a report of the learning outcomes with instructor's signature to the Advisement office.
 - Instructor will provide grade on LoboWeb.
- 2) Student enrolls in UG Honors Thesis (ME 463) with instructor's approval.
 - No later than the 4th week of the semester student prepares a written proposal and the supervising instructor AND Director of ME Undergraduate Programs approves with signature.
 - Student submits the fully approved written proposal to the ME Advisement office for student file by the end of the 4th week of the semester.
 - No later than "finals week" student will submit a written report which the supervising instructor AND Director of ME Undergraduate Programs approves with signature.
 - No later than "finals week" student provides the approved written report to the ME Advisement office.
 - Instructor will provide grade on LoboWeb.
